REGISTRATION OF THE INFORMAL WORKERS IN THE NATIONAL SOCIAL SECURITY FUND IN ORDER TO ACCESS HEALTH CARE SCHEME THROUGH THE HEALTH EQUITY FUND SYSTEM AND THE ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE FOR THE FEMALE WORKERS WHEN DELIVERY

Reference: - Article 2 of the Labour Law.

- Inter-ministerial Prakas No.404 LV/PrK.NSSF, dated 11 October 2017, on the Implementation of Health Care Scheme through the Health Equity Fund System and the Additional Allowance for the Female Workers When Delivery.

Ministry of Labour and Vocational Training would like to inform all employers or owners of enterprises/establishments under the provisions of the labour law that according to the supreme recommendation of **Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo Hun Sen**, **Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia**, the Prime Minister requested that all employers or owners of enterprises/establishments employing one worker or more shall be compulsory to register their own enterprises/establishments and workers in the National Social Security Fund of Ministry of Labour and Vocational Training in a bid to receive the social security benefits.

As the above-mentioned, the employers or owners of enterprises/ establishment, who have not registered, shall register their own workers in a hurry in the National Social Security Fund (central office) or the NSSF branches in 24 provinces and Khans from 24 October 2017 onwards.

The employers or owners of enterprises/establishments shall be liable before the law in case of failing to register their own workers in the National Social Security Fund leading to loss of workers' entitlement and benefits.

Ministry of Labour and Vocational Training strongly hopes that all employers or owners of enterprises/establishments employing one worker or more under the provisions of the labour law will exercise the essence of this notification with high responsibility.
